

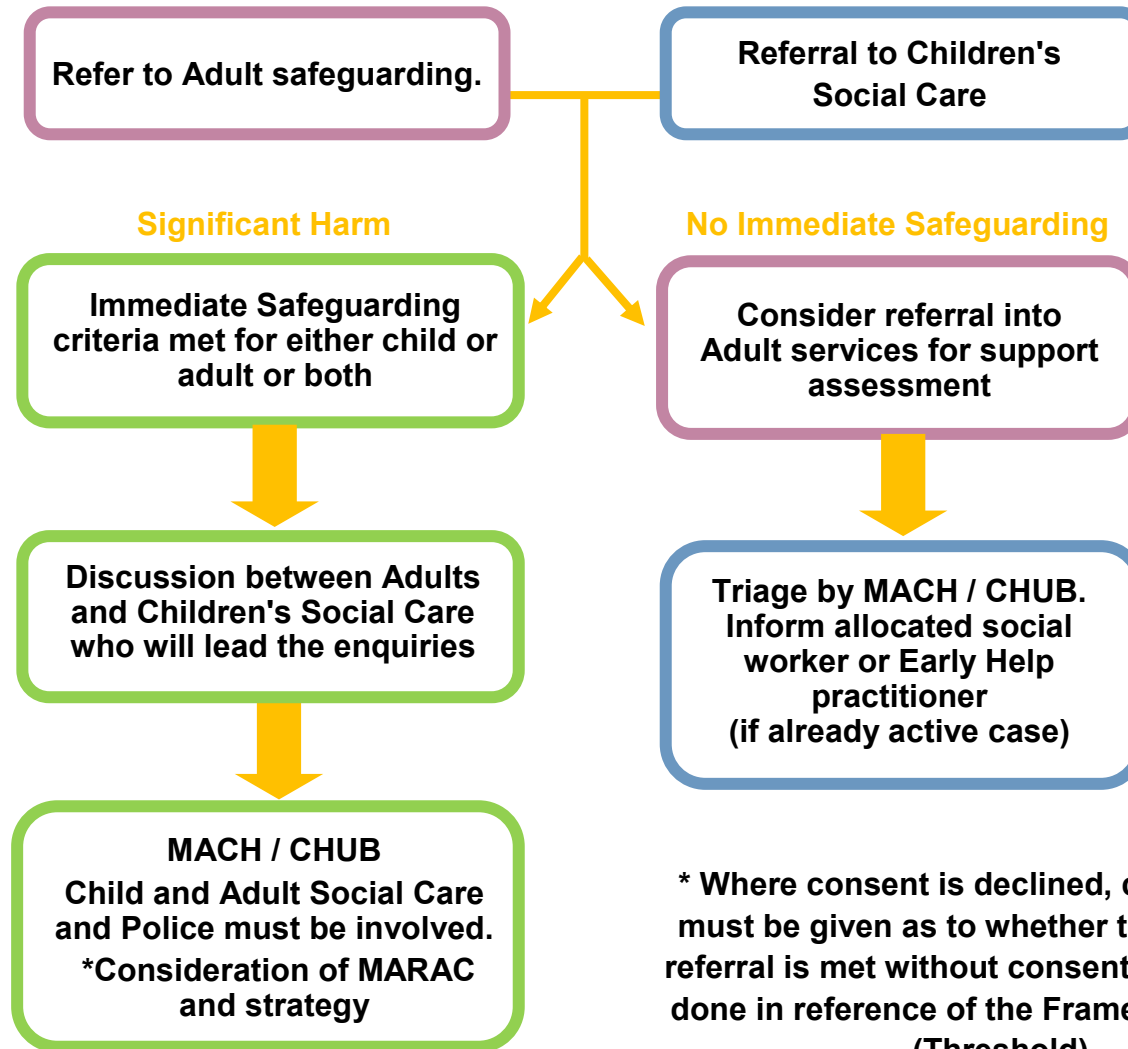
“Any act of an adolescent that is intended to cause physical, psychological or financial damage to gain power and control over a parent” (Cottrell, 2001, p. 3; San Kuay & Towel,

Safeguarding Adults will lead on safeguarding enquiries if:

- 1) there are no other children within the household;
- 2) the adult at risk has adult social care needs
- 3) the adult does not wish to proceed with safeguarding adults' procedures and there are concerns in relation to their mental capacity to make this specific decision .
